The University of Arizona will be participating in the Strive Virtual College Exploration Week (Monday, April 20 - Thursday, April 23, 2020). There are many wonderful sessions available to students for FREE, and **registration is live NOW!**

The Strive Virtual College Exploration Week provides a robust and diverse schedule of events, with 300+ representatives from colleges from around the country sharing their knowledge and expertise. Students and families can visit **StriveScan.com/virtual** to view the schedule of sessions and register for individual events.

The 96 panel presentations include a wide range of topics and the University of Arizona, will be presenting at these four sessions:

- Explore the PAC-12
- Arizona Tri-University Collaboration
- R1 Research Schools & Opportunities for Students
- College Options for Students with Learning Differences

Every panel includes the perspectives from at least three different institutions and all presentations are 45 minutes in length.

Students can browse the schedule or search based on topic, state, or specific college/university. Additionally, they can get more information on each institution presenting, including the school's location, size, average GPA, test scores, and Test Optional status.

Students should register for individually for each panel that they want to attend. Once registered, a confirmation email will be sent with the unique link to join the Zoom webinar for that panel.
